- Worked 900 hours within July 2023 July 2024
- Must have completed STAR sponsored courses, approved by the Finishing Trades Institute of District Council 36 Training Center, during the program period July 2023 - September 2024
- The **ONLY** online courses accepted are: OSHA 10. OSHA 30 and Sexual Harassment Prevention Training all which must be verified by FTI International
- $\checkmark$ Apprentices must be currently attending semester classes
- $\checkmark$ Members who have been found guilty at the DC36 Trial Board Hearings between July 2023 -September 2024 CAN NOT PARTICIPATE IN THIS YEARS STAR PROGRAM
- ✓ Full-time employees of DC36, Finishing Trades Institute of District Council 36 Training Center, IUPAT, and Contract Management (including employers) ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO WIN
